

Towards a new production model

(Abstract)

Francisco Largo Caballero foundation, driven by the UGT of Spain, has presented a new study on the need for a change in the Spanish production model, based on its fragility and inadequacy, on the current crisis and the environmental challenges. This research carried out under the direction of José María Zufiaur Narvaiza presents a multidisciplinary approach; it consists of ten works prepared by fourteen experts, which have as their objective the definition of the situation and the elements that should be changed to modify the production model Spanish in a perspective of sustainable development. It is articulated around six themes:

- The environmental challenges
- Productive base, pattern of growth and industrial policy
- Technological innovation and qualification of human capital
- Changes in the Business Organisations
- Social benefits
- Necessary reforms in the Spanish fiscal policy
